RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PROGRESS NO. 351

BYLAW NO. 11/2014

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR ROAD CROSSINGS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referenced as the "Road Crossing Bylaw".
- 2. Any crossing of a municipal road by a pipeline, flow line and power line shall be installed with the following conditions:
 - 1. all crossings shall cross the road right of way at a 90 degree angle.
 - 2. all crossings shall avoid hilltops.
 - 3. all crossings shall be bored on developed road allowances at a minimum of 2.5 m below the ditch bottom. Where there is no ditch the crossing shall be at a minimum of 3.0 m below grade. This depth shall be maintained at a minimum of 10 m on either side of the right of way boundary.
 - 4. crossings on undeveloped road right of ways may be open cut.

3. A typical road crossing diagram is attached as Exhibit "A".
