Pursuant to Subsection 102(3) and Clause 37(1)(d) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, (the PDA), **The RM of Progress No. 351 Bylaw 14/2014** is approved subject to Council effecting amendments to the District Plan as follows: 1) remove clause 3.1.13; 2) amend clause 8.2.2 to clarify the commission must consist of elected officials from each affiliated municipality; 3) amend clause 4.1.19 to clarify ILOs are not restricted to mapped areas; 4) indicate location of municipal wells and policy to protect them; 5) remove clause 4.2.20; and 6) amend clause 4.2.16 to align with *The Subdivision Regulations*, 2014.
