The North West Resource Corridor District Plan


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. Pursuant to Section 102 of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351 hereby adopts the North West Resource Corridor District Plan, identified as Schedule "A" to this bylaw.
2. The Reeve and Rural Municipality Administrator are hereby authorized to sign and seal Schedule "A" which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.
3. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Government Relations.



Pursuant to Subsection 102(3) and Clause 37(1)(d) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, (the PDA), **The RM of Progress No. 351 Bylaw 14/2014** is approved subject to Council effecting amendments to the District Plan as follows: 1) remove clause 3.1.13; 2) amend clause 8.2.2 to clarify the commission must consist of elected officials from each affiliated municipality; 3) amend clause 4.1.19 to clarify ILOs are not restricted to mapped areas; 4) indicate location of municipal wells and policy to protect them; 5) remove clause 4.2.20; and 6) amend clause 4.2.16 to align with *The Subdivision Regulations, 2014*.

The amendments are to be completed within one year of this decision.
